We are delighted to invite you to the 18th annual Haberdashers' Elstree Schools Model United Nations Conference (HabsMUN). Affiliated with THIMUN, HabsMUN is a prestigious international conference, and with this year's theme being 'Bridging Divides', it promises to be our best yet.

HabsMUN runs over three days, during which participants will get the opportunity to come up with creative solutions to real world problems, refine their public speaking skills and form alliances, all with the aim of passing resolutions to change the world as we know it. With each participant representing a UN member state, MUN will encourage them to look at global issues from different perspectives.

The conference will run from the evening of Friday 13 March 2026 until lunchtime on Sunday 15 March 2026 and will be held on our school site at Butterfly Lane, Elstree WD6 3AF. The school is northwest of London, close to the M1/M25 junction.
